School Tours

Thank you for booking a tour. We want to make your trip as fun & educational as possible. Each tour will have one tour guide & will consist of the following:

- Educational <u>walking</u> tour of orchard & vegetable fields, emphasizing growing & harvesting apples & other fall crops.
- A walk through our corn maze & the children's playhouse.
- Each child receives an apple, a cup of pasteurized apple cider, a cinnamon donut, & a small gourd pumpkin.
 - Each adult will receive an apple, a cup of cider, & a donut.

To make your tour go smoothly we suggest the following:

- Please arrive a few minutes early.
 - Late arrivals may have a shortened tour if there is a group following your group.
- Outdoor restrooms are available.
 - We ask that all school groups use these restrooms.
 - Hand washing stations & hand sanitizers are provided.
 - We have dogs on the farm. They are very friendly & love children.
- Picnic tables are available for lunch (lunch not provided).
 - It is your responsibility to clean up lunch trash.
- Children must be monitored at all times, especially in the play area & by the lake.
- We also ask that discipline be maintained on the tour.
- Your tour guide will accept payment upon your arrival.
 - If you need to use a purchase order, please inform your guide.
 - Please have an accurate count ready for your guide.
 - Payment is accepted in cash, check, or credit card.
- We will go rain or shine unless you decide to cancel.
 - Please call at least 1 hour prior to the tour for cancellations (9-5 p.m. Monday-Friday).
 - We do not have indoor facilities. Heavy rain may shorten the length of the tour.
- Make sure the children are dressed for the weather (jackets, hats, boots, etc.).
- We ask that you do not bring all the children into our market together. It disrupts our regular customers.
 Please take turns & use chaperones to visit our market in small groups.
- Yellowjackets are active in the fall, so you may wish to have your donuts & cider at school.
 - Please inform your tour guide so we may prepare your treat.

Our fee for the tour is \$5.00 per child & \$5.00 per adult (parents or chaperones). All teachers are free. Our minimum group size is 15 children. Home School groups may have one free teacher per 20 children. If your group does not have the minimum number, we can combine you with another age-appropriate group or you may pay the minimum fee of \$75.00.

We hope that you enjoy your look at our farm & learn about Ohio agriculture.



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
